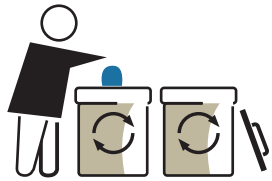
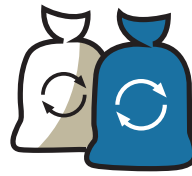


How recycled plastic lumber is made



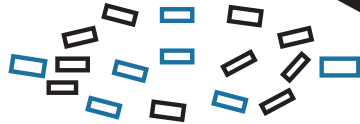
It all begins at your house. That's where packaging gets sorted into recycling bins...



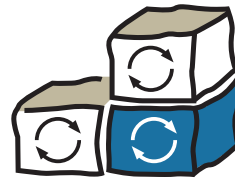
... or designated waste bags.



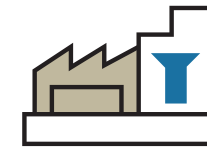
The recyclables are transported to sorting facilities.



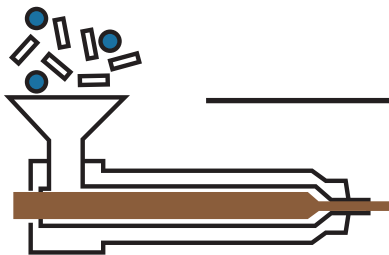
The bales are processed into pellets.



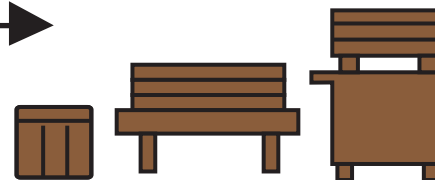
The plastic packaging waste is baled and delivered to the manufacturer.



That's where the packaging waste is separated by material (such as tin or plastics). Unrecyclable materials are sorted out.



The pellets are melted and injected into molds that are formed into lumber and other shapes. Sometimes color is added at this stage.



This is how our Outdoor Recycled Plastic Lumber products are made! They last a very long time, over 25 years, but at the end of their life, the products can be recycled, starting the cycle again.
